## Telcoinabox acquires National Telephone Networks

Telecommunications reseller and franchisor, Telcoinabox has acquired Aussiedial's Voice over IP (VoIP) and ADSL national network, National Telephone Networks to expand its existing infrastructure and support its services providers' demand for more Internet Protocol (IP) services.

The deal worth \$500,000 includes the buy-out of Aussiedial's internet services company and National Telephone Networks name.

Aussiedial's online shop AussiePCShop is still owned by Aussiedial and will continue to trade under its own brand selling computer parts and equipment at wholesale prices direct to the public.

Damian Kay, managing director of Telcoinabox says this is the first of a number of acquisitions in the pipeline.

"We have completed a period of consolidation streamlining our billing system across all our franchisees and our network providers.

"We are now concentrating on our next phase of development and that is to expand and upgrade our infrastructure through acquisition."

Telcoinabox has recently opened operations in the UK to service one of its largest service providers.

Telcoinabox provisions 100 franchisees which sell fixed wire, mobile and data services to business and residential customers throughout Australia.

Telcoinabox maintains the position as the only telecommunications franchise system and one of the top 10 telecommunications resellers in Australia.

Telcoinabox was recently named the 7<sup>th</sup> Fastest growing company in Australia and Australia's fastest growing Franchise according to BRW.
